- i. On March 24, 2020, First Justice Dunn issued a letter to the Members of the Bar, which echoes the message of Probate and Family Court Standing Order 2-20; namely, access to the courts is <u>limited</u> to emergency situations only.
- ii. Until at least **April 6, 2020**, there will not no in-person hearing on any matter that does not qualify as an emergency as defined by **Standing Order 2-20**.
- iii. Requests for Hearings (Telephone)
 - *Emergency Matter* (not yet scheduled before April 30, 2020:
 - Make the request in writing addressed to Judicial Case Manager, Patrick Yoyo at suffolkquestions@jud.state.ma.us;
 - b. In the subject line write, "Emergency Hearing Request;"
 - c. Staff can then be reached via telephone at (617) 788-8300; and
 - d. If hearing is permitted, it will be scheduled ASAP by the Court.
 - <u>Non-Emergency Matter</u> (already scheduled before April 30, 2020):
 - a. Make the request in writing addressed to Judicial Case Manage at <u>suffolkquestions@jud.state.ma.us;</u>
 - b. In the subject line write, "Telephonic Hearing Request;" and
 - c. If hearing is permitted, it will be scheduled ASAP by the Court.
- iv. Requests for Hearings (Video conference)
 - <u>Matters scheduled for hearing before April 30, 2020:</u>
 - a. Made the request in writing to Suffolkquestions@jud.state.ma.us
 - b. In the subject line write, "Video Conference Hearing Request;"
 - c. Request shall include the case name, docket number, event type, valid email addresses and phone numbers for all participants, and a certification that the

participants have a computer, table or phone with video capability and microphone/speakers with a working WIFI/interest connection and the ability to download the "realpresence" player (link will be sent via email); and

- d. If hearing is permitted, it will be scheduled ASAP by the Court.
- v. Joint Motions / Stipulations
 - Parties and counsel may submit by **mail** joint motions with stipulations for temporary orders in any pending action.
 - **Mail** the original signed pleading and accompanying stipulation to the attention of JCM Patrick Yoyo.
 - Assigned Judge will review the stipulations for allowance.
